WOODSTOCK FIRE/RESCUE DISTRICT MISSION:

The mission of the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District is to save lives, property, and the environment by providing aggressive, rapid, and skillful emergency response to all.

DEPARTMENT OVERVIEW:

The Woodstock Fire/Rescue District operates as an Illinois special district unit of local government. The District provides fire prevention, fire suppression, rescue, special unit response, and emergency medical services. A five-member Board of Trustees elected at large from the community serves as the governing corporate authority.

The Woodstock Fire/Rescue District encompasses an 82.5 square-mile jurisdiction located in central McHenry county. It operates out of three stations, serving a residential population of approximately 40,000 and protects a mix of residential, light industrial and commercial development. The District employs 63 commissioned and non-commissioned firefighting personnel, 2 civilian staff members, and 1 full time mechanic, and responded to approximately 5,600 emergency incidents in 2024.

 To complete an application and schedule your written exam, go to <u>www.nationaltestingnetwork.com</u>, select Firefighter Jobs and sign up for the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District exam. Only ONLINE applications will be accepted.

- Schedule your own convenient test time. Tests are offered multiple times a week, including Saturdays;

Upon completion of the written exam, all candidate scores will be automatically forwarded to the Woodstock Fire/Rescue District hiring officials. Candidates who attain a passing score will be placed in the department's pool of eligible candidates to continue to participate in other stages of the selection process.
